

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION DIRECT SELLERS/PEDDLER/SOLICITOR/TRANSIENT MERCHANT PERMIT

Applicants shall present to the Village Clerk for examination at the time of application:

- 1) A driver's license or some other proof of identity as may be reasonably required.
- 2) A State certificate of examination and approval from the sealer of weights and measures where applicant's business requires use of weighing and measuring devises approved by state authorities.
- 3) A state health officer's certificate where applicant's business involves the handling of food or clothing and is required to be certified under state law. Such certificate to state that applicant is apparently free from any contagious or infectious disease, dated not more than 90 days prior to the date the application for license is made.

Fee - \$100 registration/\$30 weekly fee/criminal information background check fee (CIB)
