Beer Garden Application
Annual Fee - \$35

Ordinance §349-19 provides that a permit is required for beer garden outdoor consumption. No license shall permit the consumption of alcohol beverages on any part of the licensed premises not enclosed within the building, except under a beer garden permit granted by the Village Board.

The permits are a privilege in which no rights vest and, therefore, may be revoked by the Village Board at its pleasure at any time or shall otherwise expire on June 30th of each year. No person shall consume or have in his or her possession alcohol beverages on any unenclosed part of licensed premises which is not described in a valid beer garden permit.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of ordinance §349-19 shall be grounds for suspension, nonrenewable or revocation of the licensee's alcohol beverage license or licenses.

Provisions of Ordinance §349-19

- The applicant shall file the application not less than fifteen (15) days before the date of the proposed activity or event.
- The Village Board shall review the application.
- If the nature of the property or the event requires the imposition of additional regulations, the Village Board may impose the regulations upon an express finding, detailing the reason for additional regulations.
- No beer garden shall be issued if the designated beer garden area is within 100 feet of a structure used for residential purposes, except residential uses located in the same structure as the licensed premises.
- No permit shall be issued for a beer garden if the beer garden area is greater than 50% of the gross floor area of the adjoining licensed premises.
- Each applicant for a beer garden permit shall accurately describe the area intended for use as a beer garden and shall indicate the nature of fencing or other measures intended to provide control over the operation of the beer garden.
- Every beer garden shall be completely enclosed with a fence or wall not less than six (6) feet in height.
- No amplified sound or music is permitted outside the enclosed (building) premises.
- Amplified sound or music is not permitted in the beer garden.
- There shall be a licensed operator within the beer garden at all times the beer garden is in use.
- The Village Board may approve limited exceptions to the limitations contained in this subsection upon written application therefore by the Permittee.
